lan Jones brought his pretty Flying Aces Sportster which was built from the RCM&E plan by late friend Mike Bradley.




radial cowl worked well, too. Rich himself was test flying his new Revolver design, in a fetching Red Bull scheme, look out for the plan in RCM&E soon.
